25 County employees recently completed the WiT|LA Project Management Professional (PMP) training series, developed by Auditor-Controller Systems Analyst, CISA / PMP / LEAN SIX SIGMA-certified instructor Rachel Schmeidler and Board of Supervisors PMP-certified Project Manager, Shane Putharickal. The 11-hour class series, focused on best practices, tools, and resources tailored to project management delivery in the government sector. The course emphasized the foundations to successfully pass the Project Management Institute's (PMI) PMP exam.

This no-cost course provided 11 PMP PDU and CISA CPE credits for students who completed the series. The session also featured project managers from Qualtrics, Accenture, Koru Strategies, Blue Shield of California, and LA County, who joined to share about their professional journeys.
