DATA SCIENCE SUMMER WORKSHOP SERIES

WIT | **LA** hosted its first Data Science Workshop Series last summer, together with Google Government Cloud, and Women in Data Science @ Stanford University. Throughout August and September 2021, we conducted several seminars and a hands-on lab via Microsoft TEAMS. We introduced the basics of cloud platforms, such as Google and Github, presented advanced analytical methods like Machine Learning (ML) and Artificial Intelligence (AI), and showcased use cases of problems can be solved via cutting-edge technology.

Amid the struggles and difficulties during COVID-19, these workshops attracted participants from more than 10 County departments. Attendance ranged from 50+ to 120+ at various TEAMS sessions. More importantly, we provided hands-on experience with Google Cloud. Lab participants had the choice of two ML+AI projects to experiment and practice what they learned during the workshops. For the summer of 2022, we are aiming at further collaborating with Google to provide more targeted training for County colleagues. Look for our announcement coming soon!
